GETTING AROUND IN SACRAMENTO

If you are using a bus or train to travel to Sacramento, or are parking farther away from the Capitol, a rideshare, taxi or JUMP bike can help you complete your trek.

Rideshares

JUMP Bikes

JUMP is a dockless bike and scooter sharing program run by Uber. Using the Uber app, switch from "Ride" to "Bike & Scooter" and the app will show you where bikes and scooters can be picked up.

While there are "hubs" around the Downtown/ Midtown grid, bikes and scooters tend to be available around the city locked to ordinary bike racks, poles or simply locked and free-standing near sidewalks.

You can reserve the bike or scooter with the app or scan an available bike or scooter to reserve it. If you have never used JUMP before, it will help to set up your account in the Uber app beforehand to make it easier to reserve and use a bike or scooter.
